

Spill Kit Supplies - General Laboratory

Below is a list of common items and quantities for a general laboratory spill kit. A laboratory spill kit should typically be capable of containing/cleaning a spill up to two gallons. This list must only be used as a guide. A spill kit for each laboratory must be based upon the chemicals and quantities present as well as the level of spill response training.

Neutralizer, base	lbs	2
Neutralizer, acid	lbs	2
Bag, waste, 4mil	12"x18"	5

Dust pan, small		1
Scraper		1
